DELEGATE REQUIREMENTS:

There are definitive requirements for delegates who will attend the A.M.E. Conferences. Because delegates represent Quinn Chapel at the Conference, all expenses paid, the following requirements must be considered before accepting the nomination to be a delegate. We ask that you schedule your vacation with your employer immediately upon accepting the nomination to become a delegate at any of the AME Conferences.

1. **Delegates must be able to attend conferences for the entire duration** of the conference. This includes conferences that are held in other cities or states. Because of the expense associated with traveling on behalf of the church, we need this commitment. The alternate delegate will be asked to attend only if the delegate is unable to fulfill the commitment. Please plan to be available, if necessary, from the day before the start of the conference to the close of the conference. Please notify the Pastor, church office or Carolyn Thomas, Steward Pro Tem as soon as possible if you are unable to attend.
2. **In all cases, Quinn will cover your expenses at the conferences and meetings.** This includes a cash advance to cover the various offerings throughout the conference along with travel, mileage, parking, hotel and meals. We ask that you keep accurate records of your expenses, with receipts, and submit a written report of expenses, with receipts, to the church office within one week after returning from the conference. All remaining funds are to be returned to the church office within one week of your return.
3. **Attendance at meetings and workshops is required.** The Pastor can assist in developing a schedule of meetings for the delegate to attend. Collect all pertinent Conference documents for reporting back to Pastor and Steward Board, Pro Tem. Prepare written report of observations at conference that are relative to the business of the church.
4. **Persons do not have to be long-term members of Quinn Chapel to be nominated** to be delegates for conferences. Conferences afford participants the opportunity to experience a broader exposure to the AME Church.
5. **Upon being nominated, please provide your contact information to the office:** address, e-mail address and phone numbers so that information regarding the conference can be communicated to you as it becomes available. Your travel and hotel reservations shall be booked by the office. The Steward Pro Tem shall assist with your orientation of conferences attendance requirements.
6. **Please contact the church office if you have questions at any time.**
